CHANGES TO WASTE COLLECTION

Following an extensive public consultation earlier this year, final proposals for the new services have been agreed and will be introduced in phases in 2025, to reduce waste, boost recycling rates and cut costs.

The changes include the introduction of a kerbside collection of soft plastics (crisp packets and vegetable packaging). Switching from a fortnightly to a three-weekly collection of non-recyclable (black bin) rubbish.

We have come such a long way and are now working hard to sign building contracts in July, for construction to start in the Autumn. We have clear sight on £1.7m funding.
